September 2025	FIDIC Conditions of Underground Works (FIDIC Emerald Books)	Introductory Level: The Emerald Book seeks to deal with the difficulties created by unforeseeable ground conditions primarily through the use of the Geotechnical Baseline Report ("GBR"). This is intended to be the sole source of contractual document that describes the anticipated subsurface conditions that are likely to be encountered during the execution of the Works	2 days
October 2025	Module 4 (Intermediate Level)	The FIDIC Management and Administration Course (formerly module 4) focuses on contractual mechanisms, project management features of FIDIC's major contract forms elaborating on the details of acceptable best practices	2 days
October 2025	Module 3 (Advanced Level)	The FIDIC DAB/DAABs Course (formerly module 3) focuses on legal and contractual background, mechanisms, project management features and procedural rules.	2 days
